Kingdom Strategy #1-

God wants me to KNOW my shape:

He created you uniquely and wants you to know.

You were shaped to serve God.

You are saved for service in God's kingdom and have a place, a purpose, a role and a function to fulfill.

Your life has great significance and value!



Kingdom Strategy #1 –

In this world, form follows function.

Before something is built or designed, we ask, "what is its function or purpose?".

For us, God tells us that our function follows our form.

Function follows form.

You are custom-designed and one-of-a-kind.

You are not broken. You are the way you are because you were designed for a specific purpose.

Meaning, each of us is designed to serve in a particular role or special area of expertise.



Kingdom Strategy #1 –

Kingdom Strategy # 1 –

The best use of your life is to serve God out of your shape.

"Don't act thoughtlessly, but understand what the Lord wants you to do." Ephesians 5:17 (NLT)



Kingdom Strategy # 1 –

Begin by assessing your gifts and abilities.

"Make a careful exploration of who you are and the work you have been given and then sink yourself into that."

Galations 6:4b (MSG)



Kingdom Strategy # 2 –

God wants me to ACCEPT my UNIQUE shape:

Three problems can occur when we don't embrace who God made us to be.



Kingdom Strategy #2 –

1. We compare ourselves

Comparing leaves us feeling either jealous, resentful or dissatisfied. On the flip side, if we think we are doing better than someone else or like our personality better, we can feel arrogant or proud.

Prov. 6:16-19



Kingdom Strategy # 2 –

2. We conform and try to be someone else.

When we don't understand our design and try to be like others, it increases our stress, has us saying yes to too many opportunities that are not ours to say yes too, and overall decreases our satisfaction in life.



Kingdom Strategy # 2 –

3. We project ourselves

We project our (gifts and personality) onto others and expect everyone else to act, think, behave and feel like we do.



Kingdom Strategy #3 –

God wants me to ENJOY my UNIQUE shape:

God distinctively shaped you for a life unlike any other.

Only you can be you.

"to enjoy your work and to accept your lot in life-this is a gift from God. God keeps such people so busy enjoying life that they take no time to brood over the past." Ecclesiastes 5:19-20 (NLT)



Kingdom Strategy #3 –

Don't ignore your interests.

Please don't waste your time doing work that you don't enjoy. There is something you were called to do.

God matches our calling to our capabilities.

We rarely excel at tasks we don't enjoy doing and can become easily discouraged.



Kingdom Strategy #3 –

But when we love what we do, we are both enthusiastic and efficient.

We do it for the sheer enjoyment of it. Enjoy yourself. Enjoy others!

Kingdom Strategy #4 –

Their focus is on thinking things through.



Their focus is on other people and how they feel.




