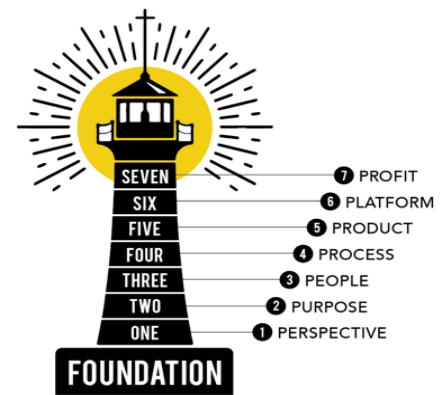
Pillar 2 - The 7 Pillars of a Kingdom Business

The 7 Pillars of a Kingdom Business

Empowered Beliefs – God is calling. Will you say Yes?
What do you need to do first...know your why!

1. WHY do we serve? Why is this so important?

We are only fully alive when we are helping others.

This truth is so important that it is repeated 5 times in the Gospels.

“If you insist on saving your life, you will lose it. Only those who throw away their lives for my sake and for the sake of the Good News will ever know what it means to really live.” Mark 8:35 (LB); Matthew 10:39; 16:25

“Each of us finds our meaning and function as a part of his body.” Romans 12:5 (MSG)

2. WHEN do we serve?

When we understand we need to shift our focus from “who’s going to meet my needs?” to “whose needs can I meet?”. From our rights to our responsibilities.

The focus of our lives should increasingly shift to living a life of service.

“Each of us will have to give a personal account to God.” Romans 14:12 (NLT)

I love this quote from Purpose Driven Life book by Pastor Rick Warren...

“...what excuse have you been using?”

Abraham was old, Jacob was insecure, Leah was unattractive, Joseph was abused, Moses stuttered, Gideon was poor, Samson was codependent, Rahab was immoral, David had an affair and all kinds of family problems, Elijah was suicidal, Jeremiah was depressed, Jonah was reluctant, Naomi was a widow, John the Baptist was eccentric to say the least, Peter was impulsive and hot-tempered, Martha worried a lot, the Samaritan woman had several failed marriages, Zacchaeus was unpopular, Thomas had doubts, Paul had poor health, and Timothy was timid.

That is quite a variety of misfits, but God used each of them in his service. He will use you, too...”

HOW do we serve is next....

Kingdom Strategy – God wants me to 1-KNOW, 2-ACCEPT, 3-ENJOY & 4-DEVELOP my Unique Shape to know how to serve...

1- God wants me to KNOW my shape: He created you uniquely and wants you to know.

1. You were shaped to serve God.

You are saved for service in God’s kingdom and have a place, a purpose, a role and a function to fulfill.

Your life has great significance and value!

In this world, form follows function. Before something is built or designed, we ask, “what is its function or purpose?”. If it is a sports arena, the form will be a lot different than if it is a church or a school.

For us, God tells us that our function follows our form. Meaning, each of us is uniquely shaped or designed to serve in a particular role or special area of expertise.

Function follows form. You are a custom-designed, one-of-a-kind, original masterpiece.

You are not broken, you are the way you are because you were designed for a specific purpose.

“We are God’s workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works.” Ephesians 2:10 (NIV)

“You made all the delicate, inner parts of my body and knit me together in my mother’s womb. Thank you for making me so wonderfully complex! Your workmanship is marvelous.” Psalm 139:13-14 (NLT)

“We are simply God’s servants...Each one of us does the work which the Lord gave him to do.” 1 Corinthians 3:5 (TEV/GNB)

2. The best use of your life is to serve God out of your shape.
 - a. *“Don’t act thoughtlessly, but understand what the Lord wants you to do.”* Ephesians 5:17 (NLT)
 - b. *“Have you experienced so much for nothing? Surely it was not in vain, was it?”* Galatians 3:4 (NLT)
3. Begin by assessing your gifts and abilities.
 - a. *“try to have a sane estimate of your capabilities.”* Romans 12:3 (Ph)
 - b. *“Make a careful exploration of who you are and the work you have been given and then sink yourself into that.”* Galatians 6:4b (MSG)

2 - God wants me to ACCEPT my UNIQUE shape:

Three problems can occur when we don’t embrace who God made us to be.

1. We compare ourselves with others which leaves us feeling either jealous, resentful or dissatisfied. On the flip side, if we think we are doing better than someone else or like our personality better, we can feel arrogant or proud. Prov. 6:16-19
2. We conform ourselves and try to be someone else. When we don’t understand our design and try to be like others, it increases our stress, has us saying yes to too many opportunities that are not ours to say yes too, and overall decreases our satisfaction in life.
3. We project ourselves (gifts and personality) onto others and expect everyone else to act, think, behave and feel like we do.

“There are different kinds of service in the church, but it is the same Lord we are serving.” 1 Corinthians 12:5 (NLT)

“I have also learned why people work so hard to succeed: it is because they envy the things their neighbors have. But it is useless. It is like chasing the wind.” Ecclesiastes 4:4 (TEV/GNB)

3 - God wants me to ENJOY my UNIQUE shape:

1. You are an original masterpiece, absolutely unique. God distinctively shaped you for a life unlike any other. **Only you can be you.**

a. *“to enjoy your work and to accept your lot in life- this is a gift from God. God keeps such people so busy enjoying life that they take no time to brood over the past.”* Ecclesiastes 5:19-20 (NLT)

2. Don't ignore your interests. We rarely excel at tasks we don't enjoy doing and can become easily discouraged.

But when we love what we do, we are both enthusiastic and efficient. We do it for the sheer enjoyment of it.

Karen says, “That’s how I feel about teaching and sharing this information with you! In doing this, I can do what God calls me to do which is to.....”

“Serve the Lord with all your heart.” Deuteronomy 11:13; 1 Samuel 12:20; Romans 1:9; Ephesians 6:6

Please don't waste your time or your life doing work that you don't enjoy. There is something you were called to do. God matches our calling to our capabilities.

Peter told us, *“God has given each of you some special abilities; be sure to use them to help each other, passing on to others God’s many kinds of blessings.”* 1 Peter 4:10 (LB)

3. We treat people the way we see people, including ourselves. Enjoy yourself. Enjoy others! You were designed to make a difference with your life and that is why you have the personality style you have, you are going to need it! **Only you can do you.**

“I glorified you on earth by completing down to the last detail what you assigned ME to do.” John 17:4 (MSG)

“[God] has created us for a life of good deeds, which he has already prepared for us to do.” Ephesians 2:10b (TEV/GNB)

“Before I made you in your mother’s womb, I chose you. Before you were born, I set you apart for a special work.” Jeremiah 1:5 (NCV)

4 - God wants me to DEVELOP (GROW) my UNIQUE shape:

When you use your personality’s strengths and abilities, you are fulfilling your calling from God.

“He saved us and called us to be his own people, not because of what we have done, but because of his own purpose.” 2 Timothy 1:9 (TEV/GNB)

“You were chosen to tell about the excellent qualities of God, who called you.” 1 Peter 2:9 (GWT)

Remember, we are made in God’s image, so we reflect God’s qualities by being us.
